The Certificate in Pre Trade Painting & Decorating has been designed to give you all the fundamental skills you need to gain employment as a painter. These include skills in industry safety, basic scaffolding, surface preparation, application techniques and related introductory skills.

Completion of this programme will put you in a strong position when applying for an apprenticeship in the industry. During the programme, you do work experience with a local employer and if you have made a good impression that may help you with your apprenticeship application. If you obtain employment you can then enrol in the Certificate in Pre Trade Painting & Decorating (with Practicum) Level 3 and receive additional credits that are equivalent to the completion of a stage one block course as a painting apprentice.
